# MCLA Proposed Objectives and Outcomes for Tier III Capstone course

OBJECTIVES: It is our expectation that students will integrate their knowledge from several disciplines, applying their academic learning and critical thinking skills to modern-day issues. In the process, they will be encouraged to become engaged citizens, working with others to make a difference in their communities.

#### OUTCOMES. Students are expected to:

- 1. Acquire and evaluate information from multiple and varied information sources.
- 2. Connect academic learning to applications within the context of local and/or global communities.
- 3. Investigate and analyze complex problems/issues and draw reasonable conclusions, providing comprehensive support for those conclusions
- 4. Effectively communicate ideas, solutions, and plans through a variety of media.
- 5. Work effectively in collaboration with fellow students and/or community entities to create a product that demonstrates the student has met outcomes 1-4. Faculty are encouraged to explore options in community-based learning for projects, but any final product which shows the student has connected academic learning and critical thinking skills with problems in the context of today's world would meet this outcome.
